


What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly to Peru

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Lima, Peru's vibrant capital city,

Day 2: Lima

- Take an expertly guided tour of Lima to see the Government Palace, Archbishop's Palace, City Hall, and the Lima Cathedral.
- Visit the 17th-century San Francisco monastery.
- Visit the Larco Museum, home to gold and silver collections from Ancient Peru, along with other outstanding examples of art and archaeological artifacts.
- Get a feel for city life during a walking tour of Miraflores—a contemporary residential district known for upscale shopping and Instagram-worthy views of the Pacific.

Day 3: Lima | Iquitos | Amazon Lodge

- Fly to Iquitos.
- Travel by boat to a jungle lodge nestled on the banks of the Amazon River—the longest river in the world.
- Hike along a lake trail with an expert local guide to experience local plants and animals.

Day 4: Amazon Lodge

- Discover some of the Amazon River's most unique wildlife on a boating excursion. Spot piranhas and look out for river dolphins, known for their pink hue.
- Visit an indigenous village to learn about the customs and traditions of the Yagua tribe.
- Search for nocturnal animal species with a local guide during a nighttime hike, and admire the starry sky above.

Day 5: Amazon Lodge

- Visit a local community, and learn about everyday life along the Amazon River.
- Observe the exotic animals that call the Amazon home as you hike through the jungle. From lush greenery to rare species, nature in this part of the world is unlike anything you've seen before.

Day 6: Amazon Lodge

- Get a bird's-eye view of the jungle during a canopy tour. Walk along suspension bridges and journey through the lush treetops of the nature reserve.
- Learn about native plants as you explore an ethnobotanical garden with a local shaman.

Day 7: Amazon Lodge

- Visit a butterfly garden.
- Explore an island nature reserve. Here, you'll meet with experts to learn about the animals that call the reserve home. Be sure to wave "hello" to some of the island's cutest inhabitants—monkeys!
- Grab a flashlight and head into the rainforest after dark to discover the Amazonian animals that only come out at night during a guided walking tour.

Day 8: Amazon Lodge | Iquitos | Lima | Depart for home

- Travel by boat to Iquitos.
- Visit the Amazon Rescue Center to learn about wildlife conservation and manatee rehabilitation.
- Fly to Lima, where you'll board an overnight flight for home.

- Visit Paracas National Park.
- Take a walk through the desert to the Morón Oasis.

Day 10: Paracas | Lima | Depart for home

- Enjoy an Islas Ballestas boat cruise.
- Transfer to Lima, and board an overnight flight for home.

Day 11: Arrive home
